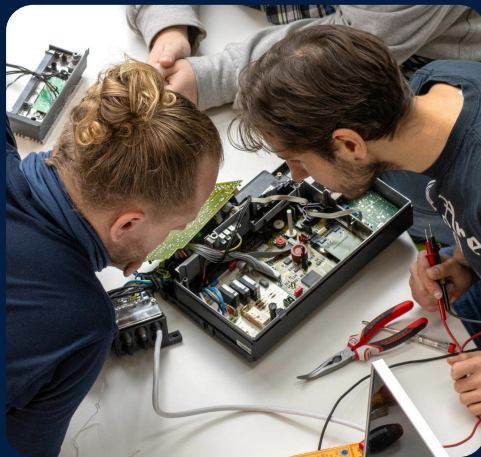

Repariertreff and Wunderrad

Since 2009, the Wunderrad Bike Workshop and, since 2014, the Repariertreff Ilmenau have promoted sustainability by **helping people repair** bicycles and everyday electronic devices. Volunteers provide tools and guidance, reducing waste, conserving resources, and encouraging practical repair skills within the community.



Tanzania: Mavuno School Project

Together with EWB Sweden, the project supports the **expansion of a girls' boarding school** in Chonyonyo, Tanzania. By contributing engineering expertise to the final construction phase, including electrical and infrastructure systems, the project helps create access to higher education and better opportunities for young women.

Completed projects

Kenya: Water for Nyamache

The first project of the regional chapter was to build a **safe water supply** for the village Nyamache in Kenya. In spring 2017, the exploration was carried out. The project was then successfully completed in December 2021, after the support had to take place remotely in the last few months.

Uganda: Electricity for a School Complex



A photovoltaic system was installed at a school in Kampala, Uganda, providing a reliable and **sustainable electricity supply**. Completed in 2023 in cooperation with the Technical University of Applied Sciences Nuremberg, the project improves learning conditions, reduces dependence on unreliable grid electricity, and delivers long-term benefits to the school community.
